Recent Death Trends by State, Grouped by Governor's Political Party 5 Slide Series, Volume 110 November 2022

Overview

This edition of our 5 Slide Series analyzes overall death rates, and COVID death rates, by state, during the past few years. Key findings include:

- States with Republican governors collectively had higher overall death rates during 2018 and 2019 (prior to COVID), 7% above the state group with Democrat governors.
- This differential has doubled during the COVID years, widening to 15%. The COVID death rate across the first 30 months of the pandemic has been 23% higher across the Republican-led states.
- West Virginia experienced the nation's highest overall (and the highest COVID) death rate during the first nine months of 2022. Utah has the lowest overall death rate during 2022; Alaska has the lowest COVID death rate.

Methodology Notes:

We assessed only the April-December portion of CY2020, so that COVID era impacts could be isolated.

Governor's political party as of early 2022 was used to group states throughout our analyses.

- During 2018 and 2019 (the last two pre-COVID years), death rates across the Republican-led states were approximately 7% above the Democrat-led state group.
 - During the COVID era, this differential doubled, widening to approximately 15%.
- Overall death rates during 2022, while far below the 2021 rate, have remained well above the pre-COVID years. The 2022 death rate was 7% above 2019 across Democrat-led states and 15% above 2019 across Republican-led states.

- During the COVID-impacted months of 2020, COVID death rates in Republican-led states were 10.8% above Democrat-led states. (Note that overall death rates were 7.3% higher in the Republican-led states during 2019, relative to the Democrat-led states, explaining most of the observed 10.8% COVID differential that occurred during 2020.)
- During 2021, the adverse differential in COVID death rates mushroomed to 35.3% in the Republican-led states; this differential has been 20.7% during the first 9 months of 2022.

Note that age mix is not driving these death rate differentials. The percentage of the total population age 65+ in the two state groups is nearly identical – 16.94% across the Republican-led states and 16.95% across the Democrat-led states.

However, the population per square mile is much larger (136) across the Democrat-led states than in the Republican-led states (70). This dynamic would be expected to create a lower rate of COVID transmission of in the Republican-led states.

State-by-State Death Rates, 2022 Year to Date

- The remaining slides convey 2022 death rate data by state.
- State rankings on overall death rates and COVID death rates during 2022 tend to be fairly similar, although there are many exceptions to this pattern.
- Rankings on percentage of the population above age 65 and on population per square mile are also shown to provide context.
